PROPHETIC WORD FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL

Around this time, the majority of professed Christians celebrate Easter. The English word Easter, which parallels the German word Ostern, is of uncertain origin. One view, expounded by the Venerable Bede in the 8th century, was that it derived from Eostre, or Eostrae, the Anglo-Saxon goddess of spring and fertility*(Britannica).

Without delving into the rightness or the wrongness of this celebration by true Christians, considering its origin, I will concentrate on the biblical intent of the season. The biblical origin of this practice stems from God's instruction to the Jews about the observance of Passover (Exodus 12:1-27). It is also very clear in the NT, that Jesus was arrested in Jerusalem during the preparation for the feast(celebration) of the Passover.

John 12:1 (KJV) Then Jesus, six days before the passover came to Bethany, where Lazarus was, whom he raised from the dead. Everything that transpired, from the Triumphant entry into Jerusalem to His resurrection, took place in the week of this celebration. Thus, the true intent and significance of Easter is lost without an understanding of Passover. Kindly read through Exodus 12 and 13.

The Passover is the night that the lamb for each household was killed, and the blood applied on the lintel of the houses that the Jew dwell in Egypt, at Goshen. This was also the night that the firstborns of the Egyptian were killed by the angel of destruction and those of the Jews spared because of the blood of the lamb that was shed. It was the night that Pharaoh urged the Israelites to leave Egypt. The passover ushers a series of events leading to the deliverance and reward of the Jews. It was a night of unusual favour upon the Jew; they spoiled the Egyptians; they received the wages of their age long service(silver, clothings and all such that they demanded).

God therefore gave the celebration of the Passover to the nation of Israel as an ordinance and a memorial. According to the scriptures, all these happened in the month of the Jews' Nissan which often falls between the Roman month of March and April. The day after their release from Egypt was called the beginning of the Year, the first day of the month Abib (April).

The month of Abib signifies a fresh beginning or what can also be called a rebirth of the nation. Prior to the Passover, they were in bondage and captivity. They were caged and abused; they were short changed and robbed. At the turn of the Passover, their story changed for the better. Abib was a new day, a glorious beginning; indeed a fresh start.

As we rejoice at Jesus' resurrection, it is the beginning of a new life and expression of the goodness of God to mankind. This month shall bring fresh light/revelation, fresh insight, fresh opportunities, fresh relationship, fresh ideas, and all you have hoped for. Welcome to the month of April, your month of a fresh start.

HEALTH TIPS

What to do During Heat Wave

- 1. Drink sufficient water as often as possible, even if not thirsty.
- 2. Use a fan, air conditioning, or a fan, and always open the window for fresh air.
- 3. If possible, avoid going out in the sun, especially between 11 am and 3 pm
- 4. Wear light, loose-fitting, porous clothes.
- 5. Use protective goggles like dark shade or sunshades, umbrella or hat while going out in the sun.
- 6. Keep skin wet by taking regular showers.
- 7. Avoid strenuous activities like exercise. Cut down on the gyms.

- 8. Avoid alcohol, tea, coffee and carbonated soft drinks.
- 9. Do not leave children in parked vehicles.
- 10. Use ORS and lemon water, buttermilk, etc. which helps to rehydrate the body.
- 11. Cancel or reschedule activities for the coolest part of the day.
- 12. Check in with others. Know if they are fine and let family, friends and neighbours know you are okay also.
- 13. If you feel faint or ill, see a doctor immediately.
