

Miracles are not Magic: A consequence, not a show

Welcome to MAY - A month of attention to instructions

Proverbs 1:8-9 (KJV) My son, hear the instruction of thy father, and forsake not the law of thy mother:

For they shall be an ornament of grace unto thy head, and chains about thy neck.

Many believers call God a miracle worker, however, it is unfortunate that we are not seeing His miracle regularly. A number of us have also been wrongly programmed to equate magic to miracle. We hear testimonies like miracle money (money that comes with no effort), miracle grades (grades received without sitting for an examination), miracle babies, etc. Many give brief and edited testimonies that leave the listeners with more questions than answers. In the end, God is successfully painted as a magician.

Don't misunderstand this. There are miracles in the Bible that are beyond human logic; as a matter of fact, all miracles are beyond logic. For example, the oil in a cruse filling up several vessels (2Kings 4:1-6), the cleansing of Naaman's leprosy (2Kings 5:1-15), five loaves feeding the multitude (Mt. 14:15-22), withered hands becoming whole (Lk. 6:6-10). These no doubt were outstanding and incomprehensible miracles.

Miracle is the divine alteration/suspension of natural process(es) to produce a natural desire. It is often inexplicable and defies scientific rules, thus it is attributed to divinity. Magic is defined as 'power of influencing an event by mysterious or supernatural force(s). The obvious fact is that Miracle and Magic look identical because both have the elements of mystery and supernatural.

However, there are some differences that are not readily seen. One, magic is the ability of one to show off while miracle is a response to a need or an intervention for a cause that is motivated by actions of those concerned. Secondly, miracle is for the benefit of the seeker while magic is for the benefit of the magician; it is a show or plot to sway benefit in favour of the performer.

It is important to note that in the scriptures, every miracle is a consequence. It is God's response or reaction to man's actions.

It is a divine response to obedience to instruction. The widow obeyed the instructions of Elisha, Namman had to dip 7 times as instructed, the widow of Zarephath had to provide first for Elijah, the man with the withered hand had to obey the instructions to stretch out his hand. We can go on and on. Miracle is not something that just happened; Miracles are Made to Happen.

Before every miracle are instructions to obey or actions to be taken by the miracle seekers. What do we have in our churches today?

We have a whole bunch of people looking for magic. We are a bunch of people that want the supernatural without desiring to pay the price. There is a price for every gain, miracle inclusive. Our churches are filled with wonder seekers who are very prayerful; jumping from place to place but do not have ears to receive instructions.

We often need to remind ourselves continually that prayers do not change God. It is designed to change us, when we receive instructions and insight at the place of prayer, and act promptly.
